McKean Hose Co. has begun the information gathering of costs/needs to make sure the

safety of McKean Residents will be covered, and will submit a request when finalized. Chief Haywood also spoke of a readiness concern if two big projects move forward in the Township. A sixty-home subdivision off Grubb Road, and industrial warehouse on Sterrettania Road with a possible 1000 employees are in the development stage. The Hose Co. is concerned if they have the coverage for emergency calls, and a ladder truck that would be sufficient for a fire call at a warehouse building the size that is proposed.
