ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 1987

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF McKEAN, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING TITLE 5, ARTICLE 121, SECTIONS 121.12, 121.17, and 121.99 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 1975 GOVERNING TRAFFIC, STOPPING, PARKING, LOADING, OR UNLOADING OF VEHICLES SO AS TO SPECIFY ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS WHEREIN STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING IS PROHIBITED.

PURSUANT TO A DETERMINATION BY BOROUGH COUNCIL THAT THE STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE LOCATIONS IDENTIFIED BELOW WOULD UNDULY INTERFERE WITH THE FREE MOVEMENT OF TRAFFIC BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF McKEAN, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That subsection (c) of Section 121.12 shall henceforth read as follows:

Within 45 feet from the intersection of curblines or, if none, then within 45 feet of the intersection of property lines at an intersection of streets other than private drives and alleys with the exceptions of the intersections at West Street and Paula Way and Paula Way and Cindy Lane, at which intersections parking shall be prohibited within 30 feet from the intersection of curblines, provided, however, that parking shall be permitted for no longer than 15 minutes along the west side of Main Street (Route 99) from the point of the intersection of the curblines of Maple Street and Main Street southward to the point where the southern boundary of the post office property meets Main Street.

Section 2; Subsection (o) of Section 121.12 shall henceforth read as follows:

On the west side of Main Street (Route 99) from a point 170 feet south of the bridge southward to a point 15 feet beyond the presently existing concrete curb.

Section 3. A new subsection (r) is added which shall read as follows:

On both sides of School Street from its intersection with Main Street to the eastern boundary of the McKean Hose Company property.

Section 4. A new section 121.12-1 is hereby added to the Traffic Code and reads as follows:

Section 121.12-1. STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING FOR FIFTEEN (15) MINUTE PERIODS. No operator of a vehicle shall stop, stand, or park such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control sign or signal for a period in excess of fifteen (15) minutes:

(a) From a point on the east side of Main Street 45 feet northward from the northern boundary of Hamot Street to a point 80 feet northward from the northern boundary of Hamot Street;

(b) Along the west side of Main Street (Route 99) from the point of the intersection of the curblines of Maple Street and Main Street southward to the point where the southern boundary of the post office property meets Main Street.

Section 5. Section 121.17(a) is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

(a) For each violation of this article there shall be attached to such vehicle a notice to the owner or operator thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of this article. Each owner or operator may, within forty-eight (48) hours of the time when such notice was attached to such vehicle, or within seventy-two (72) hours should said violation occur on a Saturday or Sunday, pay to the appropriate Borough police official the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each such attached notice or shall after the expiration of such time but within the next forty-eight (48) hours, pay Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each such notice attached to such vehicle.

Section 6. Section 121.99 of the Traffic Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this article or who fails to satisfy such violation under Section 121.17(a), and any person who aids, abets, or assists therein, is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

Section 7. This Amendment shall be effective 10/12/87.
