

REGULAR MEETING OF McKEAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

CALL TO ORDER

The June 10, 2024 regular meeting was called to order by President Dolores Oblinski, as previously advertised and took place at the McKean Borough Municipal Building.

ROLL CALL

Members present were Dolores Oblinski, Molly Davies, Rose Scouten, Mayor Weslee Clapper-Krepps, and Secretary Teri Dillen. Member absent was Eric Morgan.

CITIZEN COMMENT – AGENDA-Shawn Wroblewski (WECEMA Manager), updated Council on the storm sirens and options to consider. Testing of sirens has been quarterly until the power surge disabled the equipment. Borough Council stated they feel the siren schedule should stay quarterly, when working. He presented a bill to fix the siren for \$3002.49. It will be up to Council, McKean Twp., and McKean Hose Co., how to split the costs for repair. He also reported no incidences on the day of the Eclipse except for a traffic slow down in McKean on Rt. 99.
